CALL TO ORDER

The stakeholder consultative meeting was called to order at 10: 19 hours and one of the Ward Development Committee members gave an opening prayer after singing the National Anthem. Also, self-introductions were made.

OPENING REMARKS

The Council Chairperson expressed gratitude in his opening remarks because of the good turnout by members of the Ward Development Committee, officers for the Council and the devolved line Ministries for the 2024 budget consultative meeting which was called to receive and validate the project proposal from various wards in the district and that showed that inclusive community participation in the development agenda of the district as propagated by the decentralization policy.

He therefore encouraged all who were in attendance to participate fully and make meaningful submissions in terms of the projects that they would want to implement in the following year. He further cautioned members of the Ward Developments Committees not to involve themselves in politics because their role was to support the government of the day and ensure that development is taken in their respective wards and the district as a whole.

Thereafter, he declared the meeting officially open.

PRESENTATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF WORKS

The Director of Works presented to the meeting the projects which the Council was implementing using the Constituency Development Fund (CDF), Local Government Equalisation Fund (LGEF), own source revenue and other funding coming from cooperating partner.

Also the capital projects which the Council was implementing among which was the construction of the Fire Station, abattoir and completion of the bus station were highlighted to members by the Directors of Works.

Furthermore, the Director of Works also communicated to members on submissions received from Wards in terms of the community projects which they would like be included in the 2024 Council budget.

PRESENTATION BY THE COUNCIL TREASURER

The Council Treasurer started his presentation by informing the meeting on the sources of revenue for Chadiza Town Council namely, local taxes/ rates, fee and charges, licences, levies, permits, other incomes and National Support which includes the Constituency Development Fund, restructuring grant, capital grant, Local Government Equalisation Fund and grant in lieu of rates.

He further went on to inform the meeting that the major source of revenue for Chadiza Town Council was from the truck levy collected at Chanida boarder. However, there was need to broaden the revenue base for the Council. In line with broadening the revenue base, the Council came up with some revenue generating ventures such as the block making just to mention a few which was running well.

Also members of the Ward Development Committee and other members present were encouraged to suggest ideas which would help the Council to optimize revenue collection in order to provide quality services to members of the community.

The Council Treasurer also presented the 2023 Council budget performance which was standing at forty (40 %) percent at the time of the presentation.

QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

After all the presentations, members were given an opportunity to ask questions, sought clarifications as well as make comments. All the questions and concerns which members raised were adequately answered and clarified by the Council Secretary and members of Management who were present in the meeting.

CLOSING REMARKS

The Council Chairperson thanked all members for their actively participation and positive contributions which they made during the meeting and encouraged them to continue with the same spirit. He further requested all who were present during the meeting to share with others in their respective wards all what was discussed to avoid speculations. Teamwork was also underscored.

Thereafter, he wished all travelling mercies as they get back to their various places and declared the meeting officially closed at 13 30 hours.
